Two (croquet) balls curled up. Roll like balls when hit. static hoop. You think the ball is going through the hoop but it doesn't The balls go through the hoop The winning goal in the 1983 world cup is scored. A sporty ballet.

All performers crouch in a line Someone does a backflip All the dancers do a backflip confident, sharp, unison movements, Waves - like the sea (undulating) Everyone coming up for air

Solo - everyday washing movements getting larger, more abstract and funky in places. Duet - 2nd performer joins, counter balancing and echoing the push pull swing of jive.

The dolphin people coming out of the sea Dolphins - Jumping and rolling fluently The dolphins dive back in the sea They hair flick and the water from the sea goes on the audience

Can can music. Performers standing up on stage. They do the can can Energetically, excitedly, jumpingly The boy is always wrong, girls laugh at him Girl gets fed up with the boy and leaves Performers frozen

One performer takes off their shoes. It is somehow significant! One performer walks away a long distance, the other performer films it on camera phone. audience see through phone. One woman shouting her own name Three dancers surround the dancer. Four dancers on stage forming a square, back to back facing outwards Somebody dies (one of the performers) They fall down in an exhausted pile. When the person tells them to shut up, go away, be quiet etc. They walk away out of sight
